

# The 95<sup>th</sup> Regiment Of Teutonia.

*The 95<sup>th</sup> are highly trained in most of the weapon types but they specialize in pole arms. The 95<sup>th</sup> are loyal to Lord Viper who has been crowned King. To join this elite regiment you must first be vetted to ascertain that he/she has what it takes, and what is required.*

*The regiment will also accept REMFS (characters of any nature that do not fight in the front rank). These will also be vetted, as will all characters wishing to enter the ranks of the 95<sup>th</sup> Regiment of Teutonia. The 95<sup>th</sup> are also looking for someone to lead the REMFS; this person needs to be at a very competent level, being able to both give and take orders, also to be able to work well in a group. The regiment is also looking to recruit an experienced Ritualist.*

*The 95<sup>th</sup> motto is In Arduis Fidelis (the translation is 'Faithful in adversity'). The 95<sup>th</sup> are based in Munich, which is now a dark grey granite city constructed in the gothic style. Also housed in the city of Munich is the mighty Cathedral of Khoreg's Gate.*

*In recent times the Lost Tribe has been rediscovered, this is a race of warrior hobgoblins led by an ancient Warrior Chieftain called Sharka. Sharka has pledged some of his men to fight for the 95<sup>th</sup>. This includes his finest general, Oxton Creeper, who is now the second-in-command of the 95<sup>th</sup> (more of the hobgoblins on a separate write up).*
